EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

What is an Indulgence? "An indulgence is partial or plenary according as it removes either part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin." Indulgences may be applied to the living or the dead." (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1471) Pope Paul VI revised everything concerning indulgences; the results can be found in *The Book of Indulgences, Rules and Grants*, June 29, 1968 (Vatican Publishers). A plenary indulgence can be obtained with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for at least one half-hour and fulfill the three conditions: sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion and prayer (Our Father & Hail Mary) for the intentions of our Pope. Our Church encourages us to use this channel of the mercy of God towards the living and the dead. Adoration hours on Wednesday and Thursday from 6 a.m. to midnight. "Come."
