**FROM THE FALCONS' NEST**



With today's state and national testing requirements, schools and districts are under pressure to gather timely and accurate student assessment data. The Diocese of Toledo has a comprehensive assessment program called the "Performance Series" by the Scantron Corporation. It seems fitting that students begin taking these tests during October when we observe Respect Life. We believe that every child made in God's image and likeness is unique. Because we believe that every child learns at a different pace and has different instructional needs, these *Computer Adaptive Tests* begin by asking students questions at their grade level and then adjust automatically to each student's ability level, generating more difficult questions if the student is answering correctly and easier ones if the student is having difficulty. The approximate testing time per student per subject area is 45-90 minutes. Subjects tested include reading, math, language arts and science. Student performance data is available to teachers twenty-four hours a day at a secure password protected website in order to plan for future instruction to meet students' needs. In addition, this test enables schools to track individual students as well as overall school improvement over time.

Students in grades 5 and 8 will also take the ACRE Test (Assessment of Catechesis/Religious Education) that measures student knowledge of faith and church teachings.

Reports will be shared during November parent-teacher conferences.
